HB 696: Data Center Sales and Use Tax Credit -- Modernizes Georgia's data center tax policy to allow the current tax exemption to apply to co-location facilities with a minimum investment of \$250 million. The legislation also encourages data center development in rural areas based on population to expand technology infrastructure across all of Georgia. (2018)
