

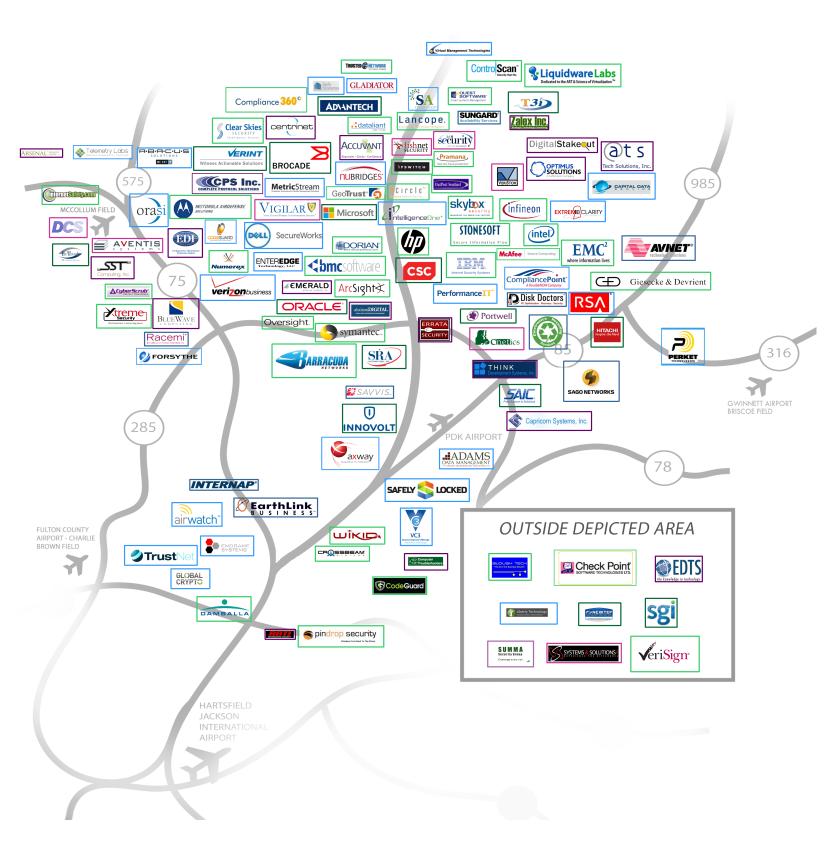
Where Georgia Leads:
